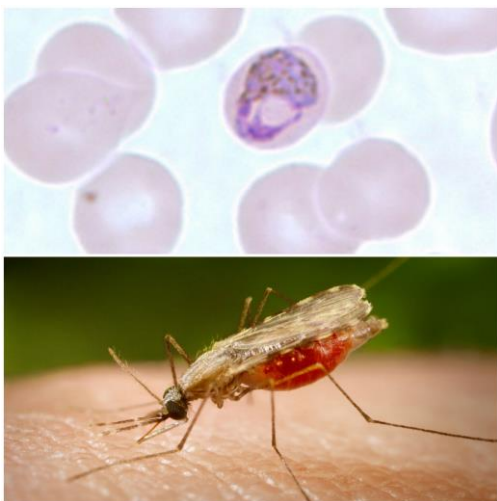

## What is malaria?

Malaria is an infectious disease caused by the presence of Plasmodium parasite in the blood (photo). The parasite is transmitted by the Anopheles mosquito. Untreated malaria can be deadly, but thanks to good medicine malaria is treatable.



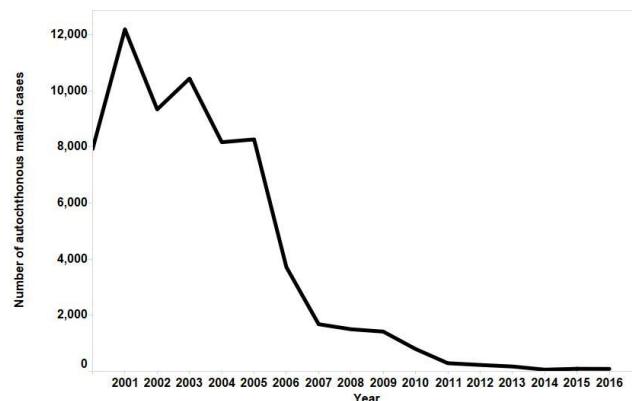
## National Malaria Elimination plan

The established goals are:

- ❖ A malaria-free Suriname in **2020** -
  - To prevent malaria reintroduction coming from other countries to areas where malaria was successfully eliminated.

## Malaria in Suriname

The number of malaria cases in Suriname has dropped from more than 12,000 infected in 2001 to merely 30 infected in 2018.



## Important advice

**If you go to areas where there is malaria**

- ✓ Always use a bednet

**If you are in or went to areas where there is malaria**

- ✓ In case of fever: go get tested for malaria at one of the test-sites for free.

**If the test shows you're positive and you have malaria**

- ✓ Always complete the treatment.

## Malaria Diagnosis and Treatment

Where can I go?

- TropClinic (Malaria Program)
- Bureau of Public Health (BOG)
- Clinics of the Medical Mission (MZ) in the interior.
- Malaria Program test - sites along the Marowijne River and in the goldmine areas.
